Submission Guidelines for SHARE

Content

ii] **SHARE** is an eMagazine and not a refereed journal. It is recommended that specialised, academic or highly theoretical articles be submitted for publication to the TESL Canada Journal.

Submission

i] All articles submitted to **SHARE** need to be sent as email attachments to jpterell@telus.net as Microsoft Word or Word Perfect documents.

ii] The writer's full contact information needs to be provided with each article.

iii] TESL Canada does not return articles submitted for publication to **SHARE**.

Length

The preferred length for articles submitted for publication in **SHARE** is 1500 words unless with there is a prior agreement with the editor.

Legal Considerations

TESL Canada asserts its copyright over complete issues of **SHARE** but the articles remain the copyright of their authors. TESL Canada retains the right to republish **SHARE** in printed or electronic format.

References

References/sources used in the articles should be listed at the end of the article.

Please ensure that the information is correct and list references/sources in alphabetical order in the following format [author, date of publication, title, place of publication, publisher]

Biographical Information

Biographical information needs to be provided for each writer whose article is selected for publication in **SHARE**. Biographical information needs to detail teaching position, teaching experience and/or qualifications, areas of special interest and all else of personal relevance to the article.

Photographs

A good quality full face photograph is required for writers of all articles selected for publication in **SHARE**. Photographs need to be sent as an email attachment in a high resolution format.
