

***Writing Puzzle: The Best Place to Live***

Write a short composition (about 100 words) about this topic, including **two** sentences from List A and **two** from List B. If necessary you may adjust those sentences slightly, so as to make their grammar fit into your composition, but you must make only small changes and you **must not change the meaning of any of the sentences that you choose.**

Because you are using sentences from both lists, your composition will contain different views about the topic. You must find a way to express your own opinion while also taking account of differing views.

Write the sentence number – (1), (2), etc – before each sentence you choose, wherever it appears in your composition. You do **not** need to use the sentences in the order by which they are numbered in the lists

List A

1. Small towns have low costs.
2. Small towns usually have very little pollution.
3. Small towns are quiet and safe.
4. Small towns are friendly places.

List B

5. Large cities are exciting.
6. Large cities have many good jobs.
7. Large cities have the best medical services.
8. Large cities have the most famous schools and universities.
